



## **Memo: PureGreen24 Application Best Practices**

Please see the following PureGreen24 Application Best Practices Instructions:

**PureGreen24 is ready to use, no mixing is required or recommended**

Microfiber cloths are recommended for the application of PureGreen24. Simply “spray and wipe” surfaces to be disinfected; ensure all surfaces are completely soaked\*, then wipe off excess. Spray and wipe to get an even distribution of PureGreen24, not to remove or wipe it away. Microfiber cloths allow you to clean while you are disinfecting, the fibers of the cloths pick-up up all of the dirt and grime while giving an even distribution of PureGreen24.

***Don't just spray and walk away.***

For irregularly shaped surfaces like children's toys, Gym equipment, door knobs or bedrails, spray PureGreen24 on the microfiber towel until a portion of the cloth is thoroughly damp, and then wipe the desired surface. The use of the microfiber cloth will ensure an even distribution. The microfiber cloth will also clean the surface while you are disinfecting.

Citric Acid is one of the nontoxic ingredients in PureGreen24, if too much product is applied the surface may feel "tacky", like that of orange juice if spilled and not wiped up. Due to the low toxicity (EPA toxicity level IV) of PureGreen24, there is NO requirement to rinse off PureGreen24 after use, even when used on children's toys.

### The Step-by-Step

1. Spray and completely wet the desired hard surface with a mist of PureGreen24 2. Wipe to ensure an even distribution of PureGreen24 with a clean microfiber cloth or towel

### Tips:

When disinfecting small items, like children's toys spray the microfiber cloth first then wipe them with the cloth. The best protocol when disinfecting a large number of very small toys is to spray all of the toys in a basket or bucket with PureGreen24, let sit for 10 minutes, then rinse off with warm water to make sure that all organic matter that be attached to the toys is removed and any excess PureGreen24 as well.

When disinfecting large surfaces such as wrestling mats, use a large dry microfiber mop or wrap a clean towel around a dust mop, spray and wet thoroughly, then wipe.

PureGreen24 kills Staph for up to 24hours after application.

\* Within 2 minutes bacteria is killed (including MRSA) A 10 minute period is recommended for killing Fungi and Viruses.

**If too much is sprayed and the surface gets tacky, wipe the excess with a cloth, soap and warm water.**

## **Memo: Las Mejores Practicas de aplicación del PureGreen24**

Debido a la baja toxicidad (nivel de toxicidad IV del EPA) del PureGreen24, no se requiere enjuagarlo despues de haberlo aplicado. Sinembargo, para evitar una acumulación de un producto residual\*\*, se recomienda que dos minutos\* despues de aplicar el PureGreen24, la superficie sea secada con una toalla limpia (papel o tela).

No se recomienda que la superficie sea enjuagada o limpiada con una toalla mojada despues de la aplicacion del PureGreen24 ya que esa practica podria reducir la efectividad del efecto residual del PureGreen24 (PureGreen24 mata el Estafilococo hasta 24 horas despues de su aplicación).

### **Etapas a seguir en la aplicacion:**

- 1.) Moje completamente la superficie dura deseada con PureGreen24
- 2.) Mantega la superficie sin tocarla pr 2 minutos\*
- 3.) Opcionalmente: limpie con una toalla LIMPIA y seca
  - a.) Sugerencia: cuando se desea desinfectar superficies grandes como esteras de lucha, envuelva una toalla limpia alrededor de un trapero grande y seco y seque a continuacion

\* Un periodo de 10 minutos se recomienda para matar Hongo y Viruses. La bacteria muere en 2 minutos (incluyendo MRSA)

\*\* Las superficies pueden llegar a ser horteras o pegajosas debido al acido citrico contenido en el PureGreen24
